2021 COMPETITION

REGULATIONS

All Competitions are “**MEMBERS ONLY**”. Invites can exceptionally participate in the competition but will not be qualified in the final results.

Each competition is played on the Par 72 and Par 64 course.

The handicap limit for the Par 72 is 18,4 for team competitions and 21,4 for Single Competitions.

The Committee can decide to change the handicap conditions in function of the number of participants. The Committee reserves also the right to close the entry list when the number of competitors reaches the limit.

The Committee may decide to prohibit players from entering a competition whose handicap is not relevant to their actual golf level, notably for lack of bringing in single scorecards.

The Committee can decide to change the competitions formulas if playing conditions require so. All Scorecards **MUST** be submitted whatever the result.

Competitors who fail to present themselves on the starting tee on time will be penalized 2 strokes; a delay exceeding 5 minutes may involve disqualification. Sanctions will be taken against players who are not present at the start without justification.

The 1st net prize has precedence over all other prizes (gross, senior, junior etc.).

In the event of equal scores all prizes shall be decided over the last 9-6-3-12-15-1 holes respectively.

The Committee reserves the right to take any action necessary for the good running of a competition.

Slow Play: If a flight is more than 2 holes behind the previous one, the entire flight can be taken out of competition.

All disputes are subject to the arbitration of the competition committee which decision is final.

READY GOLF

R&A recommendations

To improve the pace of play on our courses, please read the R&A recommendations here below.

“Ready golf” is not appropriate in match play due to the strategy involved between opponents and the need to have a set method for determining which player plays first. However, in stroke play formats it is only the act of agreeing to play out of turn to give one of the players an advantage that is prohibited. On this basis, it is permissible for administrators to encourage “ready golf” in stroke play, and there is strong evidence to suggest that playing “ready golf” does improve the pace of play. For example, in a survey of Australian golf clubs conducted by Golf Australia, 94% of clubs that had promoted “ready golf” to their members enjoyed some degree of success in improving pace of play, with 25% stating that they had achieved 'satisfying success'.

When “ready golf” is being encouraged, players have to act sensibly to ensure that playing out of turn does not endanger other players.

“Ready golf” should not be confused with being ready to play, which is covered in the Player Behaviour section of this Manual.

The term “ready golf” has been adopted by many as a catch-all phrase for several actions that separately and collectively can improve pace of play. There is no official definition of the term, but examples of “ready golf” in action are:

- Hitting a shot when safe to do so if a player farther away faces a challenging shot and is taking time to assess his options
- Shorter hitters playing first from the tee or fairway if longer hitters must wait
- Hitting a tee shot if the person with the honour is delayed in being ready to play
- Hitting a shot before helping someone to look for a lost ball
- Putting out even if it means standing close to someone else’s line
- Hitting a shot if a person who has just played from a greenside bunker is still farthest from the hole but is delayed due to raking the bunker
- When a player’s ball has gone over the back of a green, any player closer to the hole but chipping from the front of the green should play while the other player is having to walk to their ball and assess their shot
- Marking scores upon immediate arrival at the next tee, except that the first player to tee off marks their card immediately after teeing off
