



Code of Conduct Club House of the Royal Zoute Golf Club

General

This set of rules aims to ensure a harmonious and respectful atmosphere within the Club House of the Royal Zoute Golf Club. All members and visitors are required to comply with them.

Access

Access to the Club House is strictly reserved for members, day visitors (green fee players), and hotel guests.

Each member may invite non-members, provided they are accompanied by at least one member.

Dress Code

- **Bar, Orangerie and Terrace:** Casual and sporty attire is permitted, provided it complies with the dress code set out in the Royal Zoute Golf Club's Internal Regulations:
 1. Men's shirts/polos must have a collar and sleeves, and must be tucked into the trousers. Women's shirts/polos must have a collar and sleeves.
 2. Men must wear elegant knee-length bermuda shorts or well-fitted long trousers.
 3. Bermuda shorts must be worn with socks that cover the ankles.
 4. Hats, visors, and caps must always be worn with the brim facing forward and are not allowed inside the Club House.
 5. Worn-out jeans, tracksuits, t-shirts, and sports shoes are not permitted.
- **Restaurant:** During the day, players must respect the dress code outlined in the Club's Internal Regulations. For dinner service, a "casual chic" outfit is required.

Children Access

- Children under the age of 9 are not allowed in the restaurant or the bar.
- They are, however, welcome in the Orangerie and on the terrace. A dedicated "family zone" is available for parents with young children in front of the bridge room to help reduce noise.
- Out of respect for others, we kindly ask you to ensure that children remain quiet and calm. If their behavior disturbs the tranquillity of the area, we trust that parents will accompany them outside.

Pets

- Pets are not allowed.

Mobile Phones & Smartphones

- The use of mobile phones is prohibited in the restaurant, the bar, the Orangerie, and on the terrace.

Smoking

- Smoking is only permitted on the terrace, in the designated smoking area.

Respecting these rules contributes to the well-being of all and helps maintain the exceptional standard of hospitality at the Royal Zoute Golf Club.

The members of the Committee, the staff of the RZGC, and the Club House and Proshop Manager are authorised to enforce these rules of conduct.
